

10 Housekeeping rules for laboratories and operation rooms

1. Biological material (cadavers, organs, blood spillage) must be packed in plastic or risk cardboard, and placed in a designated freezer or fridge
2. Other waste (remains of isotopic material and the like) in a suitable container in a designated place.
3. Sharp, stinging and cutting objects must be put in a suitable container in the designated place.
4. Blood spills and other chemical and organic spills must be washed up (this includes worktops, under mobile devices, in extractor hoods, sinks, on PCs, monitors and equipment)
5. Dirty clothing must be thrown into a bag in the cloakroom.
6. The operating area must be prepared for the next day's cleaning and work.
7. Gas taps must be closed, and hoses and electrical wires disconnected from the wall before leaving the room.
8. Technical errors and deficiencies must be reported to the animal facility
9. Conditions concerning animal health and welfare must be reported to the with a description of conditions.
10. Tidy up and take care of own equipment when it is not in use in the Animal Department
