## Hundreds of new calls for proposals in EUs Framework program 7 and highest budget ever!

On July 20th the European Commission has launched most of its 2012 calls for proposals. The **total budget available is around 7 billion** €, the highest amount ever since the implementation of the framework programs! Calls include the thematic areas Health, Nanotechnology, ICT, Environment, Food and Agriculture, Transport, Security, Social sciences, Space and Energy. New calls were also issued in the ERC and Marie Curie programs and in the Capacities program with the popular European infrastructure and Science in society schemes. Links to all work programs are provided below. Please notice that some schemes operate with a 2-step submission process, where a five to ten page pre-proposal might have to be sent already in October 2011. Please contact the advisers if you need help.

#### Innovation is the new European buzzword

Globalisation and the current economic crisis also forces the funding for research to be more innovation-oriented in the eyes of the EU. You will therefore find the word "innovation" many times in the new work programs. If you need suitable partners among small and medium sized companies, please contact the FunderFinder team, we can help you to identify potential industrial partners through our colleagues from Innovation Norway.

#### EU positioning funding available for UIB researchers

UiB researchers can apply for positioning funding by a very simple 2-page proposal to the Division of research management (see <u>link</u>, also permanently in the section on the left side). The money can be used to finance travels to collaborators, teaching replacements or consultant services. Please note that you must send a proposal to the EU to be eligible to receive positioning funding. Contact us for more information.

## NFR rewards taking responsibility in EUs Environment and climate change program

Researchers at Norwegian institutions who take on coordinating responsibilities in a winning project in EUs Environment and climate change program this year can apply to NFRs NORCLIMA program this autumn to support their actions. Funds will be granted according to responsibilities: up to 1 million kr for coodinators, 500.000 kr for work package leaders and 200.000 kr for task leaders. Link to NFRs article (in Norwegian only)

#### Participant portal replaces EUs Cordis website

To facilitate the use of its services the commission has launched new functions on its participant portal that was previously only used to negotiate and manage projects. From summer 2011 on all calls for proposal, documentation, guidance documents and the electronic proposal submission service EPSS will also be located here. Expert evaluators can also use the portal to carry out their reviewing tasks. Please click on this link and bookmark the page.

show you relevant calls in all EU funding schemes, including also Marie Curie stipends and ERC.

#### New EU Prize for female investigators

The European Commission has announced a new prize to give public recognition to the very best women innovators who have brought their outstanding achievements to market. The aim of this new prize is to raise public awareness of the needs for more innovation and especially more women entrepreneurs in research and industry. The three winners will be selected by an independent panel of judges from business and academia. The first prize winner will receive  $\in$  100 000, with  $\in$ 50 000 and  $\in$ 25 000 going to the second and third prize winners. The deadline for application is 20 September 2011. #### Horizon2020- the new name for EUs 8<sup>th</sup> Framework program

Horizon2020 will start in 2014 with a preliminary budget of around 80 billion €. The new name received 3055 votes and won over Imagine2020 and Discover2020. EUs competitiveness and Innovation program CIP and the European Institute for Innovation and Technology (EIT) will most likely be integrated into the next framework program.
