

The Yggdrasil mobility programme - Research stays in Norway 2013-2014

Objectives:

The Yggdrasil mobility programme promotes the internationalisation of Norwegian research by offering grants in connection with research stays in Norway for Ph.D. students and younger researchers from the following countries:

<u>European countries</u>: All countries, including all <u>Council of Europe member states</u>, except for the Nordic countries (Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden).

Non-European countries: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Egypt, India, Israel, Japan, Mexico and South Africa.

Grant period:

Grant periods are from 3 to 12 months. Under this call, periods must take place between 1 August 2013 and 31 December 2014.

Type of funding:

Grants are based on fixed monthly rates. Family rate when family accompanies the visiting researcher for the entire grant period. Travel grant for applicants from non-European countries.

Application procedure and deadline:

Applications must be submitted by a Norwegian research institution via the eSøknad electronic submission service. The application deadline for 2013-2014 is 28 November 2012.
