



FIRE INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions concern everyone who has not been assigned any specific tasks in the event of a fire. The intention of the instructions is to secure that everyone leaves the building and gather at the designated assembly point to be registered.

Anyone who discovers a fire should:

- ❖ Try to put out the fire with the fire extinguishing equipment available
- ❖ Alert other people in the building
- ❖ Call the fire brigade on telephone number **110**

Evacuate the building:

- ❖ Leave the building immediately when you hear the alarm.
- ❖ Close all doors and windows to minimize the spread of flames and smoke.
- ❖ Use the nearest emergency exit. Do **not** use the lift.
- ❖ Make sure that your visitors, if any, also leave the building.
- ❖ Follow the instructions given by the person who is in charge of fire safety in your area.
- ❖ Do not re-enter the building unless you have received permission to do so from the head of fire safety for your building, the police or the fire brigade.

ASSEMBLY POINT

- ❖ : Please go to the stairs between our department and “Realfagbygget” and place yourself near person who is in charge of fire safety in your area, wearing a yellow reflex waistcoat.
