Feedback Request for the MatNat Faculty's HSE award 2021

To stimulate systematic work with health, safety and the environment (HSE) and the external environment, and to contribute to increased awareness in the HSE area, the faculty will again this year award an **HSE prize of NOK 50,000**.

The background for this is a desire to make various HSE measures at the departments visible, contribute to the exchange of experience and positive feedback to relevant professional environments and individuals. As in previous years, the award will go to an HSE measure / project that is perceived as successful and that can have value for other departments.

The HSE award is based on good, systematic HSE work that has been proven to be effective. Work / measures / projects in areas where the need for follow-up has been identified through the HSE annual reporting is of particular interest. In addition, the faculty has chosen to include measures for the external environment and IT security:

- Good routines for mapping and follow-up of the psychosocial work environment in general and the ARK survey in particular
- Routines for conducting risk assessment related to HSE
- Good routines and culture for conducting employee interviews
- Routines to ensure that employees are familiar with UiB's HSE guidelines for both physical and mental work environment.
- Measures for the external environment
- Routines that improve IT and information security
- Routines that ensure sufficient HSE competence in management, guests, new employees and safety representatives
- Other good systematic HSE work that has been shown to be effective

The prize will be awarded at the Faculty's HSE seminar in November. The target group for the seminar is the faculty board, the Information and Discussion Committee (IDU), department heads, heads of administration, research group leaders, safety representatives, HSE coordinators, fire chiefs, members of the HSE committee and all other interested parties.

Information on the time and program will be sent out over the summer. We ask the departments to submit one or more short descriptions of HSE measures / project (s) that may be relevant for the HSE award, by 30 October 2021.
