1. Offer of vaccination

2. Guidelines for sick leave

The recommendation to stay at home for seven days if you have influenza has been changed. The health authorities now recommend people to return to work/school/kindergarten 24 hours after they are symptom free at the earliest.

MARIE CURIE International Research Staff Exchange Scheme (IRSES)
Closing Date 25 March 2010

What is the Marie Curie International Staff Exchange Scheme?

The action is aimed at strengthening research partnerships through staff exchanges and networking activities between European research organisations and organisations from third countries with which the Community has an S&T agreement (or are in the process of negotiating one), or in countries covered by the European Neighbourhood Policy. This action will provide support to research organisations to establish or reinforce long-term research co-operation through a coordinated joint programme of exchange of researcher staff for short periods.

Who can apply?

At least two independent research organisations established in at least two different Member States or Associated countries, and one or more research organisations either located in countries with which the EU has an S&T agreement or are in the process of negotiations, or in countries covered by the European Neighbourhood Policy. Eligible countries are listed in Annex 1.2 (page 47) of the 2010 PEOPLE Work Programme. Please note that you can also set up such a program with Australia, Canada, Japan, NZ, Rep of Korea, USA, Hong Kong and

Macao, but that the participants cannot receive EU funding, but your staff gets funding to spend time abroad.

How does it work?

Proposals are submitted, evaluated against a set of criteria by international peer review and selected for funding of 3-4 years.

What is the budget

30m EUR

What does the funding cover?

* Financial support will be provided for a period of 24 to 48 months, to joint programmes aiming at trans-national mobility of researchers, technical and management staff for a maximum duration of 12 months. For organisations in Member States and Associated countries, the mobility must be towards the third country partners, and vice-versa.

* The staff to be exchanged should be "seconded" (i.e. maintain their salary in their institution of origin, and have the right to return)

* The grant agreement will be concluded with the participants located in the Member State or Associated country, while the other members of the partnership are defined as partner organisations. The size of the joint programme and of the partnership will depend on the number of expected researchers, technical and management staff to be exchanged.

* In principle, the scheme is intended to provide a balanced exchange of researchers between the European partners and the third country partner organisations, each respectively funding the mobility costs of their 'outgoing' researchers.

* The fixed Community contribution is 1900 EUR per exchanged staff member per month. This amount should cover the cost of travel and subsistence of the exchanged staff. Networking actions, management costs and overheads related to the execution of the exchange may also be included in the contribution. For countries located a long distance from Europe (see list of eligible countries in Annex 1.3 of the WP), an additional long distance allowance of 200 EUR per exchanged staff member per month is paid.
