Summary Statement:

My research, since coming to Auckland 20 years ago, has always had a dual focus involving either applications of archaeological science in the Pacific Region or the Prehistory of the Solomon Islands. In the last 7 years my archaeological science interest has matured while my active involvement in the Solomons has come to dominate my fieldwork and writing. Increasingly I see these two lines of research coming together in more fine-grained analyses of the data being generated by the Solomons fieldwork, resulting in the application of powerful analytical techniques to questions of social transformation and history in Melanesian society late in prehistory. My research is markedly collaborative and inter-disciplinary and since 1996 I have led 2 large research teams (Roviana Lagoon and Vella Lavella Projects) composed of members from 3 countries and four Universities in the investigation of the prehistory and history of the Western Solomons. This research has and will continue to provide field experience and financial support for a considerable number of graduate students (since 1996: 5 MA, 6 PhD). I have two books in process on this research. In 2006 I was awarded my third Marsden Grant as a co-PI with John Cassidy from Geology. This will generate the first record of mid to Late Holocene variation in geomagnetic field strength for the SW Pacific using dated archaeological ceramics. As well as providing base data for modeling of change in the geomagnetic field it is hoped that the curve will provide an additional independent dating technique of use to archaeologists in the region and provide a means of dating intertidal ceramics from the Solomons. In Dec 2007 I also conducted some work in Roviana to try and reconstruct the history of lagoon formation as this is crucial to understanding the Lapita record in this part of the world as well as providing data on uplift and tectonic activity in this area which has recently suffered from a major earthquake. I am also working with geologists in New Zealand to establish a chert sourcing database for northern New Zealand. Data collection is complete and a database has been constructed and analyzed, publication is in process.
